Even YOU Can Get Answers to Prayer

Leader's Notes

I. You can get answers to prayers.

- Prayer is communication with God including receiving answers.
- Prayer is not “trying” to get something from God.
- God already knows all things.
 - Hebrews 4:12-16, *“For the word of God is alive and powerful. It is sharper than the sharpest two-edged sword, cutting between soul and spirit, between joint and marrow. It exposes our innermost thoughts and desires. Nothing in all creation is hidden from God. Everything is naked and exposed before his eyes, and he is the one to whom we are accountable. So then, since we have a great High Priest who has entered heaven, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold firmly to what we believe. This High Priest of ours understands our weaknesses, for he faced all of the same testings we do, yet he did not sin. So let us come boldly to the throne of our gracious God. There we will receive his mercy, and we will find grace to help us when we need it most” (NLT).*
- The place of prayer is the throne of grace.
- The way to get answers to prayer is to believe God.
- Study God’s Word to find out what He has already given you.
- Pray according to what God has given you.
- God cannot lie; therefore He will keep His promises.
- You have the right to expect results through the power of the living God.





Expect Results From Prayer

II. Believe that you receive.

- You have the right to believe that you receive.
 - Matthew 21:22, *"You can pray for anything, and if you have faith, you will receive it" (NLT).*
 - Mark 11:24, *"I tell you, you can pray for anything, and if you believe that you've received it, it will be yours" (NLT).*
- Develop an attitude of honesty to yourself and to God. Nothing is going to change until you believe.
- Jesus came to set you free to receive from God.
 - John 3:16, *"For God loved the world so much that he gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life" (NLT).*
- God is available to you.
- Your prayers minister to others.

III. It is your right to receive from God.

- Set God's Word as the standard for your life.
- The man who knows how to pray is wealthy and peaceful.
- You have a right to believe God and expect results when you pray.
