## Pray All the Time

### Quick Study Guide

#### I. You should always pray.

- God's Word is available and Jesus' Name is offered to whoever will believe.
- There is no situation that will disqualify you from prayer.
- God's Word is His part in your prayers.

#### II. As you pray you need fundamental knowledge of God and the Lord Jesus Christ.

- You must accept three truths to align your thinking with God.
  - Prayer is not trying to get God's attention.
    - God's eyes and ears are open to your prayers.
  - Prayer is not trying to get God to do something.
    - God has already done everything.
  - Prayer is communication with God—believing and receiving what He has already given to us in Christ Jesus.
- Your job is to pray according to the Word of God in the Name of Jesus.

#### III. Weapons are to be used in prayer.

- You can use God's armor as a weapon to defeat the devil.
- These weapons are not to be used against people.
- Definition of *might*—"the ability to accomplish anything."
- The armor of God is specifically for prayer.





# Change Things Through Prayer

## Scriptures for Contemplation

### Luke 18:1

*"Men always ought to pray and not lose heart" (NKJV)*

### 1 Peter 3:12

*"The eyes of the Lord watch over those who do right, and his ears are open to their prayers" (NLT).*

### Hebrews 4:13

*"Nothing in all creation is hidden from God. Everything is naked and exposed before his eyes, and he is the one to whom we are accountable" (NLT).*

### Ephesians 6:10-13

*"A final word: Be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. Put on all of God's armor so that you will be able to stand firm against all strategies of the devil. For we are not fighting against flesh-and-blood enemies, but against evil rulers and authorities of the unseen world, against mighty powers in this dark world, and against evil spirits in the heavenly places. Therefore, put on every piece of God's armor so you will be able to resist the enemy in the time of evil. Then after the battle you will still be standing firm" (NLT).*

## Confession

I pray to communicate with God. I believe His Word and I receive the answers to my prayers as I pray in Jesus' Name. I use the armor of God to defeat the enemy and stand firm watching my God change things.
