Use Jesus' Prayers as Your Guide

Quick Study Guide

I. Jesus is the authority on prayer.

- Jesus said, *"It is written"* (Matthew 4:4, 7, NKJV).
- For results, build your foundation of prayer on the rock, the Word of God.
- Ask God in prayer.
- God hears your prayers because you pray according to the Word and the will of God.
- Believe that you receive.
- Then, give thanks and praise that God hears and answers you.

II. Choose to live a life of love.

- It pleases God when you choose to live a life of love, not allowing strife or confusion to have any room to operate.
- Keep God's commandment of love.
- To get results in prayer, love one another.

III. Center your life in Christ.

- Jesus said, *"Abide in Me."* That means: to prepare and settle in (as in a home).
- Be transformed into the image of Christ.
- Begin with the answer; that is, the scripture you believe for the situation.
- Apply faith and speak as if it were already done.
- Praise the Lord.
